We refer to our message of 4 September 2013 whereby we informed you of the extension of the timeframe for handling of your case as well as to your telephone conversation with Mr. Rando, whereby you were provided with information about the mandate of the EIB Complaints Mechanism as well as of the Fraud Investigations Division of the EIB, which is responsible to carry out inquiries on alleged fraud and corruption.

From the review of your first message to the EIB Infodesk of 17 June 2013, it results that you intended to lodge a complaint concerning the allegedly bad management of an (unidentified) EIB-financed project in Romania. From a following message (a Complaint Form sent to the EIB-CM on 23 June 2013), it results that the Project in question is the Rehabilitation of DN14. In your message, you explain that *"although I am not an engineer...I have doubts that the work done is of good quality..."*).

We regret to inform you that the information you have provided the EIB-CM with is not sufficient to justify the opening of a formal inquiry into the case. Should you wish to further pursue the matter and have at your disposal evidence substantiating your allegations, you are kindly requested to provide such evidence by no later than 13 December 2013, after which – in the absence of further elements – the EIB-CM will proceed to the closing of the case.
