1.	Where should I have to attach these documents? In which envelope? envelope 1 for annex 1? envelope 2 for annex2? or envelope 3, that eventually collects the substitutive self- declaration and the experience demonstration request?	Eol must be drawn up on paper in duplicate, i.e. one original and one copy, clearly marked as “Original” and “Copy”. An electronic copy in MSWord or PDF format on a single CD-ROM marked with the name of the entity shall also be submitted. All the supporting documents shall be included in the inner envelope, as described in the front page of the Call for Expression of Interest (Eol).
2.	What form do you suggest for the documents to be submitted under Selection Criteria? Substitutive self-declaration as well?	<p>In relation to Selection Criteria:</p> <p>(c) Relevant experience: Relevant experience shall be provided by means of the template, in table format, included in the Terms of Reference of the Call for Eol.</p> <p>(d) Minimum rating: In case a candidate does not have itself a rating but is backed by an entity which holds a majority of stakes in the candidate and has the power to direct the management and policies of the candidate, whether through the ownership of voting capital, by contract or otherwise (i.e. Parent Company), the rating of the Parent Company will be taken into consideration for the selection criterion related to the Minimum Rating provided that a letter of support issued by the Parent company confirming it will support the engagement of the candidate under the Agreement is attached to the documentation accompanying the Eol.</p> <p>With regard to selection criteria e) and f), the EIB will be satisfied with self declaration for the purpose of the Eol submission. The EIB reserves however the right to verify the correctness of the information received, at any time.</p>
3.	Which kind of documents (and how many) do you require to certify that an applicant can carry out business in its country? Can you give me an example? Is it ok, for instance, the Chamber of Commerce Certificate?	Evidence to be provided for this matter may consist, inter alia, on registration with the official companies registry, trade register, chamber of commerce, authorisation issued by Bank of Italy or other competent authority, etc.
