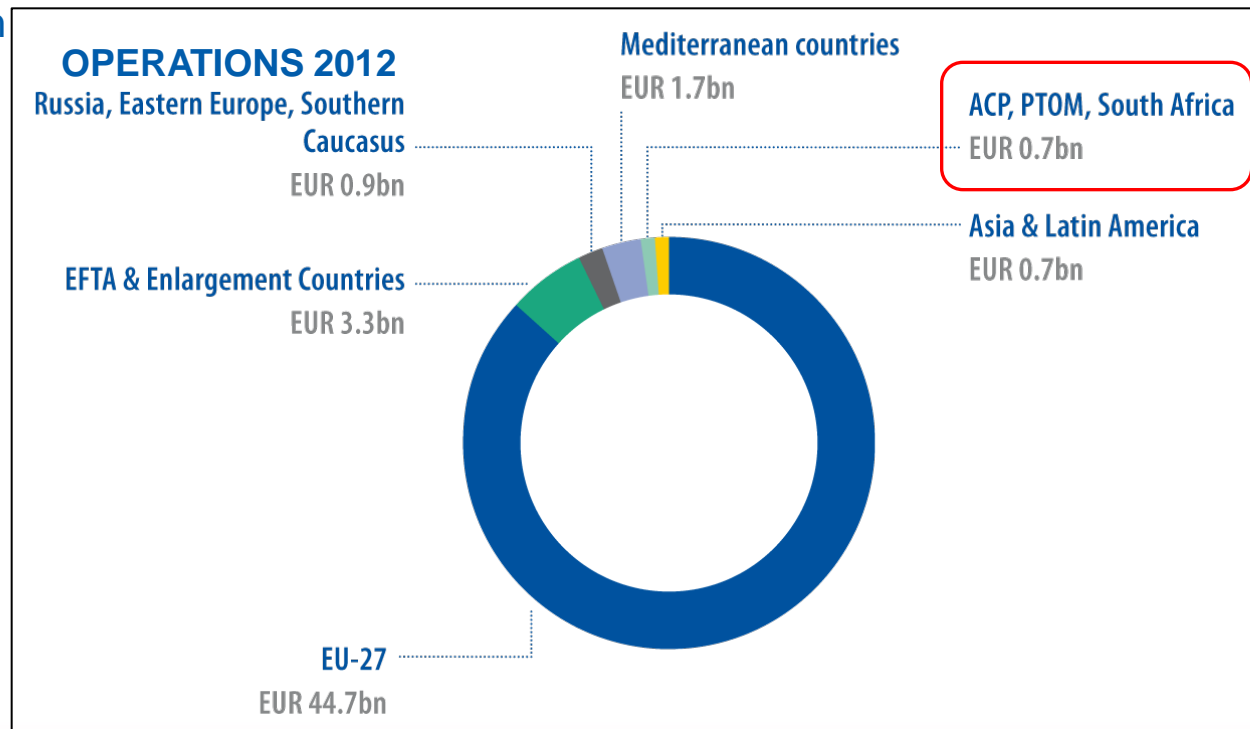
# The European Investment Bank (EIB)



- European Union's long-term lending bank set up in 1958 by the Treaty of Rome
- European Investment Fund (part of the EIB Group)
- Shareholders: 28 EU Member States

2013 marks the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the EIB activities in the ACP countries

It is also 10 year anniversary of the Investment Facility

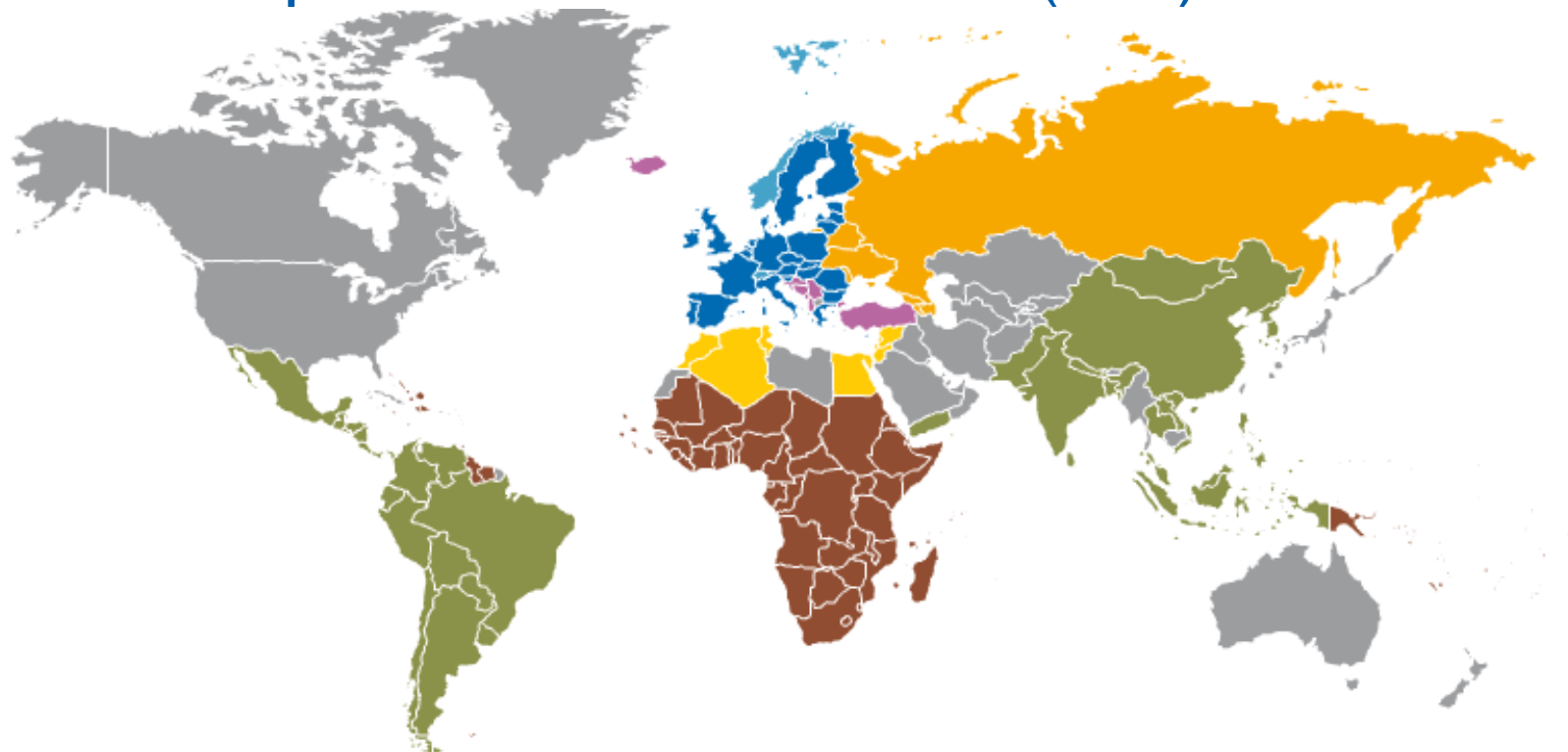

# The European Investment Bank (EIB)



- Cuba, Equatorial Guinea, Sudan and Somalia are not part of the EIB mandate as they have not signed/ratified the Cotonou Agreement or its revisions
- **South Sudan** will be part of the mandate soon (upon ratification of the Cotonou Agreement)



## Water & sanitation

The EIB has invested nearly **EUR 450m** in water & sanitation projects in the ACPs and OCTs since 2003

The UN has declared 2013 the **International Year of Water**



- According to UN, more than one in six of the world's population does not have access to clean drinking water, and two and a half billion people live without even basic sanitation
- EIB works closely with the European Commission, financial partners, local authorities and NGOs, to support projects that contribute to achieving the **Millennium Development Goals on water and sanitation**
