WELL-BEING, IMPACT AND INNOVATION



An unprecedented humanitarian aid package of more than €3.5 million supported those affected by the war in Ukraine. We also made donations following humanitarian catastrophes in Tonga, Indonesia and Pakistan.

BOOSTING TALENT



Belonging, the largest ever exhibition of the EIB collection spanning eight different venues, in Limerick (Ireland) drew 26,000 visitors, making it the most attended external exhibition to date.

Liviu Bulea (Romania), Pauline-Rose Dumas (France), Elsa Mencagli (Italy) and Laure Winants (Belgium) were the laureates of the 10th edition of the Artists Development Programme, mentored by Tatiana Trouvé, and held at Cité des Arts in Paris. Another artist, Nikolay Karabinovych, received financial and formal backing, further demonstrating the Group's support to Ukraine.

Scouting for diverse talent for the EIB art collection continued, resulting in the acquisition of work by socially-engaged artists with an Asian heritage.
