#### **Environmental Assessment**

**Overview** 

The project activities do not fall under Annexes I or II of the EIA Directive 2014/52/EU amending Directive 2011/92/EU, and are therefore not subject to mandatory Environmental Impact Assessments. The proposed investments will take place inside existing RDI facilities already being used for similar activities, and are not expected to have a significant environmental impact on the surroundings.

Most RDI activities relate to development of IT and engineering solutions such as a software tool to provide advanced and predictive simulation of the production and business processes of manufacturing activities resulting in energy efficiency improvements of the manufacturing process.
