Project Description: The Project supported an investment programme of the German

Federal State (Land) of North Rhine-Westphalia (NRW) for the provision of reception centres and adequate temporary

accommodation for asylum seekers.

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following key Environmental and Social outcomes at Project Completion.

The investment programme comprised refurbishment, upgrading and new construction of reception and temporary accommodation centres, where the asylum seekers stay before they are assigned to temporary or permanent housing units under the responsibility of the municipalities.

As percontractual obligations, reception centres have met the requirements of the EU Receptions Conditions Directive (2013/33/EU). The EU Reception Directive clarifies the grounds for granting international protection and leads to more robust determinations, thus improving the efficiency of the asylum process and prevention of fraud, and ensures coherence with the European court's judgments.

The promoter, BLB¹ NRW, is a publicly owned construction, real estate and housing company affiliated to the German Federal State of North Rhine-Westphalia. All schemes were implemented in line with the requirements stipulated in their respective authorisations/permits. No significant environment or social issues were reported.

EIB is of the opinion based on the reports from the promoter that the Project has been implemented in line with EIB Environmental and Social Standards, applicable at the time of appraisal.
