Project Description: Construction of a rail link between the tram line of the city of Gmunden and the Traunsee regional railway and acquisition of rolling stock.

The project consists of:

- A 900 metre long double track railway track through the inner city of Gmunden, connecting the existing terminal station of the tram with the terminal station of the Traunseebahn;
- Replace the existing but life-expired road bridge over the river Traun,
- Redesign and renovate the main road through Gmunden (Theatergasse/ Kammerhofgasse) and part of its main square (Rathausplatz), integrating the tram-train tracks.
- Acquisition of 11 low-floor light rail trains, each 33 metres long, which will be acquired on a lease contract basis. They will have 76 seats and a total capacity of 180 passengers.

After project completion, a new 18 km long railway service between Gmunden and Vorchdorf has commenced full revenue service.
