## EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The project concerned investments in research and development activities carried out in already existing and authorised R&D facilities. The project did not fall under any of Annexes of the Environmental Impact Assessment Directive 2014/52/EU amending Directive 2011/92/EU and therefore, did not require screening or EIA Report.

No significant environment or social issues were noted during implementation of the project. Overall, the project has been assessed as acceptable having no adverse impact on the environment.

New and innovative products launched on the basis of research and development activities have helped the clients of Prysmian to perform better with respect to energy use, sustainability and environment. Specifically, the products of Prysmian facilitate transmission of large quantities of electricity over long distances, improve network reliability, reduce cost of offshore wind farms and lessen the impact of construction work necessary in installations, thus supporting the shift towards renewable energy sources. A portion of the R&D activities also developed recyclable and eco-sustainable cables.
