#### **Overview**

Project Description: The project involved the design, construction, equipment supply,

financing, facility management and clinical support services of an integrated public hospital campus. The project is located on the outskirts of Bursa (Turkey) and replaces the existing six ageing hospitals operating at the time in the Bursa administrative and health

regions.

## **Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion**

EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The project did not experience any significant environmental and social issues and was not subject to a national EIA process. These are not required under Turkish legislation for hospital projects. The construction of the hospital was on vacant land with little ecological value.

The promoter secured licenses and permits for the tri-generation plant by July 2020. As required by the EIB, the promoter performed a full Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA), including for the tri-generation plant, and a comprehensive ESIA report by independent consultants was to satisfaction of the EIB, and the findings and recommendations of the final report in compliance with EIB environmental and social standards.

The project has brought significant economic and social benefits to the area. The construction phase led to the creation of over three thousand jobs and the hospital campus now plays the role of an excellence centre, consolidating the high quality hospital services for half of the entire Ankara region.

### Summary opinion of Environmental and Social aspects at completion:

EIB is of the opinion based on reports from the promoter, site visits by the EIB team and inputs provided by Lenders' Supervisors and others during Construction that the Project has been implemented in line with EIB Environmental and Social Standards, applicable at the time of appraisal.
