The road opened to traffic in 2019). |

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

## The EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The project concerned the construction of a new 14.4 km 2x2 lanes motorway section of the D1 between Budimír and Bidovce and the construction of a 1.06 km 2x2 lanes express road section of the R2/R4 from the intersection of Košické Olšany to the intersection of Hrašovík on road I/50.

At the time of the project appraisal and subsequent approval in March 2022, the project was completed. The road was opened to traffic in December 2019.

The mitigation measures set during the multistage consent procedure were properly implemented except in relation to the protection of the wetlands and the water regime on the wetlands in Rozhanovce (not part of Natura 2000). Consequently, it was decided to implement a wetland revitalization project in Valaliky. The borrower shall ensure that these works are contracted not later than 30 June 2024 and completed not later than by Q4 2027.

As part of the final project certificate, a final survey of the land-take was carried out and the administrative process to acquire the additional land (2.2377 ha.) is, as of November 2022, 80% complete.

## Summary opinion of Environmental and Social aspects at completion:
