investments were carried out in the period between 2018 and 2021.

## EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The investment programme included investments in RDI on innovative shower systems to further develop and industrialise the current products, some R&D capex to empower the company's R&D and testing capabilities as well as investments to support the company's commercial expansion primarily in the EU. The project activities did not fall under the Annexes I or II of the EIA Directive 2011/92/EU as amended by the directive 2014/52/EU. The project was carried out in existing facilities, already authorised, that did not change their scope due to the project. As such, the project activities were not subject to an Environmental Impact Assessment.

Overall, the project's environmental impact was very limited. The investments contributed to the adoption of the company's products, thus entailing energy and water saving in different applications fields, notably showers for hotels, residential installations and other applications where higher water recyclability allows for improved user experience (e.g. recreational vehicles and cruise ships). As such the investments contributed to the sustainable use of resources.

No significant environment or social issues were noted.
