Project Description: *The project concerned RDI investments of a proprietary portfolio of nuclear medicine solutions for diagnosis and treatment of cancer, addressing a range of indications such as neuroendocrine tumours, bone metastases or prostate cancers. This portfolio includes new radionuclides and radiopharmaceuticals in various stages of clinical development, covering discovery, pre-clinical and clinical (Phase I-III) and technical validation phases.*

### Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

**EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.**

The project involved the financing of internal R&D in strategic discovery programmes linked with high unmet medical needs and new partnerships to accelerate innovative products along the drug discovery chain. All activities have been implemented in line with the Technical Description and expectations at the time of appraisal with no major issues on the environment. The research and development activities in pharmacy and biotechnology were carried out in existing facilities already authorised for the purpose. The project's activities neither fall under Annex I nor Annex II of the EU EIA Directive 2011/92/EU amended by Directive 2014/52/EU. The use of animals for scientific research purposes within the scope of the project, if applicable, has been conducted in compliance with Directive 2010/63/EU. The clinical trials were conducted in line with the Clinical Trials Directive (EC) No. 2001/20/EC and its national implementing legislation.

No significant environmental or social issues were noted.

**Summary opinion of Environmental and Social aspects at completion:** Based on reports from the promoter, EIB is of the opinion that the Project has been implemented in line with EIB Environmental and Social Standards, applicable at the time of appraisal.
