### Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

**EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.**

The Project comprised the renovation, extension and construction of lower secondary schools in the Department of Gironde in France. The scope of 14 sub-projects has been implemented.

#### Environmental Impact Assessment

At appraisal, it was indicated that an Environmental Impact Assessment was required for the new school Mayaudon located in Bordeaux. After appraisal, the definition of the component evolved and the Promoter confirmed that an EIA was ultimately not required, but the site was subject to an assessment with respect to France's *Loi sur l'Eau*, relative to the Water Framework Directive, due to its impact on aquatic environments. Compensatory measures were required to mitigate the impact of the new construction. The Promoter has provided the letter from the competent authority validating the new construction and compensatory measures.

#### Energy Efficiency

The Promoter's energy performance objectives defined at appraisal were achieved for the components within the Project scope. All constructions and renovations were implemented in accordance with energy efficiency standards applicable at the time of implementation.
