## **Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion**

EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at **Project Completion.** 

The project consisted in an Investment Programme covering various energy and environmental sub-sectors, namely district heating, micro-cogeneration, public lighting, electricity distribution, hydropower, energy efficiency in buildings and in street lighting, waste collection and treatment, water supply, the development of sustainable mobility solutions and a component of ICT infrastructure, aimed at the efficiency, unification and security of the group ICT network.

The project contributed to a reduction of energy consumption and a reduction of CO2 emissions. The project contributed to Italy's environmental and climate action targets. In addition, the operation led to improved air and water quality standards and the reduction in solid waste pollution.

No Environmental Impact Assessment was required for the implementation of the project. The Promoter did not report any environmental and social concern.
