Project Description: Multi-component investment programme covering the

period 2021-2023 aimed at renovating and reinforcing the electricity distribution network in Greece. The programme consists of a large number of medium and low voltage electricity distribution schemes geographically dispersed throughout peninsular and insular Greece. The main purpose of the program is to enable the connection of new system users and to improve the current standards of safety and reliability

of the network.

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion:

The investment programme comprised a large number of Medium Voltage (MV) and Low Voltage (LV) electricity distribution schemes, including new and refurbished MV and LV network, and automation and advanced metering infrastructure, geographically dispersed throughout the country. The schemes of the programme did not exceed the thresholds for screening set out in the national legislation as per provision of Article 4(3) of the EIA Directive 2011/92/EU as amended by Directive 2014/52/EU. Therefore, none of these schemes were subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA).

The promoter was required to implement the provisions of articles 6(3) and 6(4) of the Habitats Directive, where applicable, and store and keep updated any documentation that may be relevant and that supports compliance with the Habitats Directive.

The promoter did not report any environmental and social issues during implementation.

Summary opinion of Environmental and Social aspects at completion:

EIB is of the opinion based on reports from the promoter during construction that the Project has been implemented in line with EIB Environmental and Social Standards, applicable at the time of appraisal.
