investment programme of the Region of South-Moravia that will improve the regional infrastructure, in particular in the sectors of

transport, health and social care

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following Environmental and Social performance and key outcomes at Project Completion.

The project delivered 5 transport infrastructure upgrades, 8 new EMS bases, and 2 homes for the elderly. All sub-projects were implemented in line with Czech and EU environmental law, including the Public Procurement Act and relevant EU Directives (SEA, EIA, Habitats, Birds, Water Framework).

No negative environmental impacts were reported for any component.

Where required, EIA procedures were applied to transport-related projects, and no negative environmental impacts were reported for any component.

The project delivered significant upgrades in transport, health, and social care infrastructure, with a strong focus on energy efficiency and climate action. EMS bases and health facilities were designed to high energy efficiency standards (plus energy), using photovoltaic panels, heat pumps, and rainwater harvesting, directly reducing CO₂ emissions and operating costs.

Risks identified include skilled labour shortages and extreme weather (floods, tornadoes), but no significant operational issues are ongoing.

The project improved intra-regional connectivity, road safety, and the quality and availability of public services, particularly in health and social care. New and refurbished facilities have enhanced quality of life and service delivery for residents, aligning with the ESDS's expectations for positive social outcomes. No adverse social impacts or resettlement issues were reported.

All facilities are operational and serve their intended purpose, with improved service quality and capacity in transport, health, and social care. Cost increases and schedule extensions were mainly due to COVID-19 and the war in Ukraine; some components saw cost savings from procurement.
