Project Description: The project is part of the promoter's ongoing investment

programme to expand the gas transmission infrastructure in the Netherlands, thus strengthening its ability to meet gas demands in northwest Europe. The investment consists in the construction of the two pipelines—Odiliapeel-Melick (65 km) and Beverwijk-Wijngaarden (90 km)—in the southeast

and west of the Netherlands respectively.

A full Environmental impact assessment, including public consultation according to the EU EIA Directive was required for the 2 gas pipeline sections. The relevant competent authority issued the following environmental consent:
