It will comprise both capital and intangible expenditures. The latter will include the proportion of the researchers' remuneration dedicated to medical R&D.

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following key Environmental and Social outcomes at Project Completion.

No significant environment or social issues were noted.

The project involved mainly intangible basic research activities in medical research (94% of the project cost) by various entities, while the rest of expenditures was equipment purchase and minor refurbishment schemes. None of the schemes included in the project required EIA.

Medical research has a high value for the society. It contributes to better health care services delivery resulting in improved health status of the population, thus, overall the project.
