Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following key Environmental and Social outcomes at Project Completion.

As established in the ESDS at appraisal, the project underwent the necessary procedures for an amendment to the integrated environmental permit and the development consent (*Genehmigungsbescheid*) was granted before the promoter started implementation. The competent authorities issued the corresponding integrated environmental permit (*Endgültiger Genehmigungsbescheid*) in October 2016 and the final operational permit the same month. This coincided with the conclusion of the construction and start of operation of the two firing lines in the fully refurbished plant.

The promoter therefore obtained all permits for the construction and the operation of the waste to energy plant in a timely manner

No significant environment or social issues were reported for the project during the implementation and early operation phase to date.

Summary opinion of Environmental and Social aspects at completion:

EIB is of the opinion based on reports from the promoter during Construction and early operation that the project was implemented in line with EIB Environmental and Social Standards as applicable at the time of appraisal.
