Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following key Environmental and Social outcomes at Project Completion.

No significant environment or social issues were noted.

One component of the project was the modernization of the hospital's power plant. To supply the hospital with thermal energy and electricity, the hospital has been equipped with new a combined heat and power plant running on natural gas. While under normal circumstances this plant is regulated according to the thermal demand, the plant functions as the emergency power supply in case of power cut and the usage of diesel generators can be reduced.

The refurbished facilities allow the hospital to improve hygiene and safety conditions within the hospital while the modernised power plant can be operated with significantly reduced emissions.
