Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following key Environmental and Social outcomes at Project Completion.

No significant environment or social issues were noted. The project involved construction and refurbishment of the hospital infrastructure in the Helsinki and Uusimaa in the Uusimaa region in southern Finland. None of the schemes included in the project required EIA.

The project does not present any significant environmental or social risks. On the contrary, given the nature of the project, it is likely to have positive ramifications on social cohesion and the general well-being of the population.

EIB is of the opinion, based on reports from the promoter, that the project has been implemented in line with EIB Environmental and Social Standards, applicable at the time of appraisal.

The project is an integral part of the Energy Efficiency Agreement signed between HUS and the Ministry of Employment and the Economy, aiming at saving of 25,1 GWh (or 9% of annual energy consumption in 2008) for the period of 2008 – 2016. The final achievement for the period 2008 – 2016 (based on the 2005 consumption) was 23,835 GWh on 31.12.2016.
