Allocation of three major road schemes: construction of Nowolazurowa Street, and a new interchange and capacity extension and modernisation on Siekierkowska Route, to be financed under the already approved Warsaw Municipal Infrastructure III framework loan (2009-0104).

Summary of Environmental and Social Assessment at Completion

EIB notes the following key Environmental and Social outcomes at Project Completion.

The project includes three road infrastructure schemes: (1) capacity extension of Siekierkowska Route between the intersections with Marsa Street/Zolnierska Street and Naddnieprzanska Street, (2) construction of an interchange between the Siekierkowska Route and National Road no. 2 (Phase IIc); and (3) construction of the southern part (Stage 1) of the new Nowolazurowa Street from Jerozolimskie Street to Juliana Chroscickiego Street.

Scheme (1): Environmental Decision 238/OŚ/2008 was issued on 25.02.2008 and extended with Decision 108/OŚ/2012. Noise barriers and facilities for vulnerable road users are being implemented as part of the project, however, the installation of the barriers are temporarily suspended due to pending court proceedings related to land acquisition.

Scheme (2): Environmental Decision WŚR.I.SM/6613/86/06 was subject to appeals filed by the Polish Society for the Protection of Birds. Decision DOOŚ-131D/1018/2008/JSz later revoked some of the clauses of the original Decision and resulted in the implementation of additional environmental mitigating measures. A post-completion analysis on environmental issues was completed.

Scheme (3) Environmental Decision 1482/OŚ/2006 was issued on 23.10.2006 and upheld by Decision 253/OŚ/2010. Acoustic screens and road surface treatments with the best possible acoustic performance applied as required, and new street greenery was planted.
