

The Small Grants Programme provides targeted financial support of up to EUR 3 000 per initiative to foster inclusive, sustainable and resilient communities through concrete, high-impact projects implemented by local actors. It welcomes requests from not-for-profit organisations across the European Union active in the field of youth, education and community resilience, while placing particular emphasis on community initiatives based in Luxembourg.

Applications for Small Grants agreements are **now open**.

Eligibility

The programme is open to:

- Not-for-profit organisations registered in an EU country and active in the field of youth, education or community resilience
- Community initiatives based in Luxembourg

Additional conditions:

- Requestors must not have received two or more EIB Institute (EIBI) small grants within the past four years
- Individuals are not eligible

What we donate

Eligible requestors can receive up to **EUR 3 000** for the sponsorship of a specific initiative. All donations are subject to budget availability and the evaluation of the fit between the request and the EIBI objectives.

To ensure funding supports initiatives that deliver meaningful and measurable results, shortlisted applications are assessed against several criteria. All applicants will be informed of the outcome **before the end of the third quarter of 2026**.
