- a) Construction of the new 15,000 m³/d water treatment plant
- b) Equipping the new 15,000 m³/d water treatment plant
- c) Upgrading pumping equipment at the Dingue-Dingue Raw Water Pump Station to produce a raw water flow of 81,200 m³/d flow
- d) Upgrading pumping equipment at the Mutua Clear Water Pump Station to produce a 75,000 m³/d flow of clear water
- e) Bulk electrical installation and upgrades
- f) Implementation of a supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) system to operate and monitor the new treatment module
- g) All associated works.

*Description of the procurement

FIPAG, the implementing agency, now invites eligible construction firms (“Contractors”) to tender for the construction of the Works. Procurement of the Works will be conducted through Open Procedure (*Most Advantageous Bid using Rated Criteria: Bid with the highest combined technical and financial score*) as specified in the Guide for Procurement for Projects Financed by EIB (herein referred to as EIB’s GtP), July 2024 revision (available online at [Guide to procurement for projects financed by the EIB](#)).

There are no eligibility restrictions based on the Contractor's country of origin. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation process set out in the bidding documents. The following weightings shall apply for Rated Criteria, including technical and non-price factors (technical evaluation) 80% and for the Bid cost (financial evaluation): 20%. Contractors may associate with other firms in the form of a Joint Venture, Consortium or Association (JVCA) to enhance their qualifications. The type of association shall be clearly stated in the Proposal. The experience and financial record of any proposed sub-contractor shall be included in the evaluation. The evaluation criteria are as follows (In case of applications submitted by a JVCA, these selection criteria will be applied to the overall JVCA as a whole):

a) The Bidder shall demonstrate financial capability to meet cash flow requirements estimated as USD 4.0 million, with a minimum average annual construction turnover of USD 30.0 million over the past five years;

b) Be a reputable contracting firm with experience in construction contracts for at least five (5) years;

c) Has since 1 January 2015 substantially completed:

(i) 2 (two) similar contracts with a minimum value of USD10.0 million each

Or

(ii) 1 (one) similar contract with a minimum value of USD20.0 million.

The similarity of the contracts shall be based on

- civil construction contracts for a complete Water and/or Wastewater Treatment Plant (as opposed to individual components) with capacity of at least 15,000 m³/d;
- design, supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of mechanical and electrical equipment for construction of a complete Water and/or Wastewater Treatment Plant (as opposed to individual components) with capacity of at least 15,000 m³/d;
- design, supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of mechanical and electrical equipment for construction of a pump station with capacity of at least 75,000 m³/d; and

- 1 (one) contract for assembly, installation and programming of SCADA monitoring software, including optic fiber, radio connections between stations and control centre for Water or Wastewater Treatment and/or Pump Station installations

d) Has since 1 January 2015 successfully completed

- (i) 2 (two) contracts in Sub-Saharan Africa;
- (ii) 2 (two) civil construction contracts for a complete Water and/or Wastewater Treatment Plant with capacity of at least 15,000 m³/d;
- (iii) 2 (two) mechanical and electrical construction contracts that includes design, supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of equipment for a complete Water and/or Wastewater Treatment Plant (as opposed to individual components) with capacity of at least 15,000 m³/d;

e) Experience in managing the following Environmental and Social risks and impacts:

- (i) The development and implementation of a Contractor environmental and social management plan on at least three similar contracts;
- (ii) The development and implementation of an environmental and social management system (ESMS) on at least three similar contracts; and
- (iii) Development and implementation of an occupational health and safety policy and plan in compliance with EIB Standards and/or World Bank Guidelines on at least three similar contracts.

f) The Bidder must demonstrate that it will have a suitably qualified Contractor's Representative and suitably qualified (and in adequate numbers) Key Personnel, as described under Section III. Evaluation and Qualification Criteria of the Bidding Document;

g) The Bidder should demonstrate proven experience with FIDIC conditions of contract, in particular FIDIC Red Book, 2nd Edition 2017.

Tenders and associated documents must be opened in public, in the presence of representatives of the tenderers if they wish to attend, authorised representatives of the Contracting Authority (FIPAG), Promoter (GREPOC) and the TA consultant representatives, on a date and at a place indicated in the Procurement Notice or tender documents. Tenders arriving after the deadline for receipt are not to be opened. At the opening of tenders, the name of the tenderers and the amount of each tender, including any special conditions, must be read out aloud and recorded in the minutes of the tender opening. The said minutes must be signed by all the attendees and be shared with them for record. Under this procurement process, the Bid comprises two Parts, namely the Technical Part and the Financial Part. These two Parts are submitted simultaneously in two separate sealed envelopes (two-envelope Bidding process); thus, FIPAG will publicly open and read out the Technical Parts of Bids received by the deadline, at the date, time and place above mentioned. Following the completion and notification of evaluation of Technical Parts of the Bids, the Public Opening of Financial Parts of ONLY the Bids evaluated as substantially responsive to the bidding document and met the eligibility and qualification requirements, will take place. All bidders will be notified, in writing, of the date, time and location of the second public opening.

However, Bidders who do not attend the Pre-Bid Meeting and/or Site of Works visit shall present evidence in their Technical Proposal (using the form Site of Works Visit Declaration) of having visited the site of works together with authorized representatives of FIPAG / AdRC.

All Bids must be accompanied by a **“Bid Security”** in the amount of **US\$ 300,000.00.**
